ITx combines three successful IT-related conferences, establishing the broadest and largest non-vendor general IT conference in New Zealand.

ITx brings together the best from the IT industry, research community and education sector and features the latest in innovation, technology and education.



The Institute of IT Professionals NZ is New Zealand's leading body for those working or studying in Software and Information Technology (IT) related fields.

With thousands of members throughout New Zealand and direct relationships with Government, academia and the industry, IITP is the authoritative voice of the Information Technology profession.

Previous IITP conferences have attracted a who's who of the IT sector, with a diverse range of speakers and a host of experts from every corner of IT.

The Institute has been representing the profession for 54 years and hosted the main IT conference for much of this time. After an extended hiatus, IITP (then the NZ Computer Society) began running regular conferences again with the major 50th Anniversary Conference in 2010, followed by a successful national conference in Tauranga in 2013.

TRADE EXHIBITION

A trade exhibition will be held at the conference. In order to provide you with the optimum exposure to delegates the exhibition will be located in the foyer, pre-function and common areas of the venue.

The basic setup provided for stands are side and

back partitioned walls. The configuration of individual stands may vary.

Each stand will include the following:

- Velcro receptive display panels
- 1 x 10 AMP power supply and a multi-box
- 2 x 100 watt spot lights
- A trestle table, table cloth and a chair
- · Installation and removal of basic set up

Internet access can be provided at an additional cost. Any additional requirements will be the responsibility of exhibitors and at their own cost.

Site

The trade exhibition area floor plan (available soon) will show the sites of trades exhibition stands. Sponsors will have first option for positions, followed by those exhibiting without sponsorship.

Lunches, morning & afternoon tea breaks will be held in this area.

High impact areas

There are also a limited number of high-impact Large and Standard Trade Stand areas available. These will be in the direct room foyer area of the conference rooms, where people are constantly moving between sessions.

While these will be high impact areas, they will need to be moved out for the Excellence in IT Awards Gala Dinner on Thursday night of the conference (as the entire area will be opened up and used for seating). Thus, these stands will consist of the table and floor area but not partitioned walls. Freestanding signs are okay though.

Exhibitor Benefits

Each exhibiting company will receive the following benefits:

- Acknowledged as an exhibitor with a name listing in the conference handbook.
- Trade attendant registrations. Trade attendant registration entitles the recipient to entry to the trade exhibition, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea. These can be swapped amongst rostered exhibitors as long as only one person is using each pass at a time. It does not include entry into conference sessions or social events.
- Super: 3 free trade attendant registrations
- Large: 2 free trade attendant registrations
- Standard: 1 free trade attendant registration
